Solicitation No. PSC-17-3006, Construction Administration and Inspection Services for Project No. TN-49, Replacement of the Roadway Deck in the Suspended Spans at the Throgs Neck Bridge (TNB)

THE TRIBOROUGH BRIDGE AND TUNNEL AUTHORITY (TBTA) is seeking Expressions of Interest for the above-mentioned solicitation, at its office, 2 Broadway, 24th floor, New York, NY 10004. The Work to be performed under this Contract shall include construction administration and inspection services through project close-out to support the construction of Project TN-49. Tasks include: pre-construction services; construction administration, inspection and testing; independent confirmatory inspection and testing and; post construction and project close-out. The construction Scope of Work includes but is not limited to: (i) removal of existing roadway deck; (ii) installation of a new orthotropic deck, overlay, drainage systems; (iii) removal and replacement of portions of median and parapet barriers on the Queens and Bronx Anchorages; (iv) strengthening and repair of floor and stiffening trusses; (v) removal and installation of new sign structures; (vi) installation of a new fire standpipe system along the Bronx Approach Viaduct and the TNB suspended spans; (vi) removal and installation of new roadway lighting along suspended spans and the Queens Approach viaduct spans; (vii) installation of new modular and armorless joint systems; (ix) cleaning, preparing and overcoat painting of specified areas on the suspended span; (x) abatement of lead containing materials; and (xi) Maintenance and Protection of Traffic.

The Consultant shall provide at minimum the following: (a) Project Manager; (b) Resident Engineer; (c) two (2) Assistant Resident Engineers; (d) two (2) Chief Inspectors; and (e) two (2) Office Engineers. Senior project team members must be Professional Engineers registered in the State of New York. All respondents must comply with NYS Education Law Section 7209. The contract range is in excess of \$15,000,000. The estimated contract duration is four (4) years and four (4) months. The mandatory MBE/WBE and Service Disabled Veteran goals for this contract are to be determined.

Interested firms must submit one (1) original and five (5) copies of a Letter of Interest, Standard Form 330 and the Authority Forms C-021 and RFQ-4 (Rev. 8/22/12) and the Proposer Diversity Practices Questionnaire. **Submittals must be no more than thirty-five (35) pages of text in length printed double-sided, the C-021, RFQ-4 form and the Proposer Diversity Practices Questionnaire will not be included in the 35-page total.** All respondents are advised that in the interests of waste reduction and maximizing the potential for recycling, respondents are requested to use at least 30% post-consumer recycled content paper to the extent practicable and to avoid using plastic binders, plastic dividers and/or plastic tabs and comb and velo binding in preparing their submittal. You may obtain the Authority forms C-021, RFQ-4, SF 330 and the Proposer Diversity Practices Questionnaire from our website, www.mta.info/bandt/procure/homeproc.htm. The Authority will then evaluate these submittals and develop a short list of firms who will receive a Request for Proposal that must be obtained for **Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) dollars**. We accept Visa, MasterCard and American Express for the purchase of solicitations. **All purchases are non-refundable.** International firms must provide checks

in US funds. (Company checks and money orders only, no personal checks or cash). All vendors on the short list of firms to receive a Request for Proposal must follow instructions for SAM and FedBizOpps at www.mta.info/bandt/procure/preactcon.htm. If you require services to be provided to you in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, please contact Procurement Administration at (646) 252-7092 or TTY/TDD (646) 252-7089.

Responses must be received at the below listed address no later than Wednesday, September 20, 2017 at 3:30 P.M. Copies of the solicitation documents shall be obtained from the TBTA in accordance with the instructions herein. Any proposal submitted by a vendor who did not obtain the solicitation documents directly from the TBTA will be deemed non-responsive and not be eligible for award of the contract.

Prospective proposers are further notified that, effective with the date of this letter, the Restricted Period for this procurement as defined under State Finance Law §§139-j and 139-k, as amended by Chapter 1 of the Laws of New York 2005 ("Lobby Law") is hereby commenced. Accordingly, all inquiries concerning this procurement shall be directed solely to the Point of Contact, Harold Booth, Field Contract Manager, hbooth@mtabt.org – (646) 252-7308 for this procurement, or other person(s) designated by the Authority as authorized to receive communications on behalf of the Point of Contact (Designated Point(s) of Contact). In the event that Harold Booth cannot be reached, the Alternate Designated Point of Contact is David Hanley, ghanley@mtabt.org – (646) 252-7344. All communications (e.g. phone calls, e-mails, meetings) with the Authority, regardless of form, by a proposer or his or her representative that a reasonable person would interpret was an attempt to influence the procurement -- referred to as "Contacts" -- shall be made only to the Designated Point(s) of Contact. Contacts made to other than the Designated Point(s) of Contact, are prohibited ("Prohibited Contacts"). All proposers should be aware that a finding that a proposer engaged in Prohibited Contacts with Authority personnel other than the Designated Point(s) of Contact can result in a determination of non-responsibility and ultimately, debarment if a proposer engages in a similar Prohibited Contact within a four year period. Any determination of non-responsibility or debarment due to violation of the Prohibited Contacts requirements of the Lobby Law will be posted on the NYS OGS website.


Please note: All hand deliveries (including messengers) of bids/proposals must be delivered to the 2 Broadway Mail Center's entrance, which is off the loading dock at the side of the building and can be reached from Marketfield Street. Please allow extra time for delivery. All packages will be inspected and visitors will be required to show two forms of identification, including photo id.
