Fields Mapping for xml equipment data for Application Developers

Xml TAG	Description	Example
<NYCEquipments>	Root element in xml output	
<responsecode>	This response code represents success, error, or no data condition in xml output generation 0 : success, one or more equipment -1 : error	
<message>	Indicates message associated with response code, if any.	
<equipment>	Represents each equipment record	
<station>	Indicates Station Name	34TH ST - PENN STATION
<borough>	Indicates borough of Station	MN
<trainno>	Train Number	1/2/3/LIRR
<equipmentno>	Equipment number of elevator or escalator	EL456
<equipmenttype>	Indicates what type of equipment it is. EL - Elevator ES - Escalator PW - Power Walk	ES, EL or PW
<serving>	Serving location	STREET TO MEZZANINE
<ADA>	Whether elevator or escalator is ADA compliant or not	Y or N
