Mets-Willets Point Travel Tips

Travel Tips

- Arrive early to support your team.
Extra service will be provided before each game.
Buy round-trip tickets in advance.

Transferring at Woodside to Mets-Willets Point

- Tell on-board crewmembers that you're traveling to Mets-Willets Point.
Remember to keep your ticket stub; you'll need it when you get to Mets-Willets Point.

Arriving at Mets-Willets Point

- Watch the Gap when exiting trains.
Please have your tickets ready to present to gate collectors.

Leaving Mets-Willets Point (after the game)

- MTA police will employ an eastbound and westbound queuing system to ensure the safe and orderly boarding of trains.
Wait times vary based on attendance.
Extra service will be provided after the game.
LIRR personnel will be on hand to assist you with boarding.
Listen for announcements providing train information.
Watch the Gap when entering trains.

Transferring at Woodside to Mets-Willets Point

Woodside is the transfer station between Long Island points and Mets-Willets Point. Customers traveling from stations on Long Island should change at Woodside to the Port Washington Branch trains shown in this timetable for service to Mets-Willets Point.

Trains to Mets-Willets Point depart from Platform B at Woodside.

Trains from Mets-Willets Point arrive on Platform C. Trains to Jamaica and points east leave from Platform A. When tickets are collected on your train, inform crew member that you are going to or from Mets-Willets Point so that ticket can be properly serviced and returned for use on connecting train.

ADA Accessibility Note

LIRR customers with mobility impairments who are traveling to see the Mets at Citi Field ballpark should travel to Woodside Station. At Woodside Station, which is ADA accessible, customers should transfer to a Flushing-bound #7 subway train to the Mets-Willets Point subway station, and then use the ramp to reach Roosevelt Avenue, across from Citi Field ballpark. To return to Woodside after the game, customers with mobility impairments would need to board the #7 subway and travel one stop east to its end point, the Flushing-Main Street Station. There, after a brief wait on the train, the subway will head west to Woodside. (This is necessary due to the location of the ramp, which will only permit access to the eastbound platform.)
