CONNECTING SERVICE

PATH
Transfer at Hoboken. PATH (Port Authority Trans-Hudson) service operates a rapid-transit system between New York and New Jersey with frequent service throughout the day. PATH trains operate between Hoboken Terminal and World Trade Center in downtown Manhattan. Running time is approximately 11 minutes. PATH train schedules shown herein are for information only and connections cannot be guaranteed.

PATH trains also operate between Hoboken and midtown Manhattan, stopping at Christopher Street, 9th Street, 14th Street, 23rd Street and 33rd Street. Consult a PATH service guide (available at PATH stations) for schedules, or visit www.pathrail.com.

NJ TRANSIT PENN STATION CONNECTION

Change trains at Secaucus Junction for convenient connections to Penn Station, New York in Midtown.

NJ TRANSIT #126 BUS

Frequent service from Hoboken to Port Authority Bus Terminal (8th Ave. and 41st St.) midtown Manhattan.

NY WATERWAY

Monday thru Friday - Hoboken Ferry service operates to/from lower Manhattan (World Financial Center and Pier 11) between 6:00AM and 9:30PM. Running time is approximately 10-20 minutes.

Saturday and Sunday - Hoboken Ferry service operates to/from West 38th Street in midtown Manhattan. Ferries operate between 10:00AM and 9:30PM on a 30 minute frequency. Running time is 15-20 minutes.

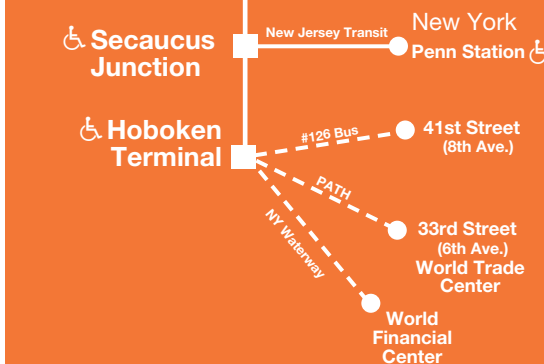
