

Port Jervis Line Customers

Substitute Busing

Weekday, Off-Peak, Mon. April 9 - Fri. May 4 - 8 AM - 4:30 PM

Substitute bus service will be provided between Port Jervis and Ramsey Route 17, for **off peak service only**, weekdays, 8 AM to 4:30 PM, from Monday April 9, through Friday, May 4.

Buses will replace Port Jervis Line trains between Port Jervis and Suffern.

Inbound

Substitute busing will be in effect beginning with the 9:26 AM from Port Jervis, and train service resumes with the 9:27 PM train from Port Jervis.

Buses will depart stations at the scheduled train time and travel to Ramsey/Route 17, where customers will transfer to trains.

Outbound

Substitute busing will be in effect beginning with the 8:28 AM from Hoboken, and train service resumes with the 4:08 PM departing Hoboken.

Outbound buses will depart Ramsey/ Route 17 Station approximately **five minutes after** the connecting train arrives and travel directly to each Port Jervis Line station.
