JOB DUTIES: Perform expert-level and complex work involving the troubleshooting and repair of electric and hydraulic elevators, escalators and associated electro-mechanical equipment. Utilize schematic diagrams, technical manuals and drawings to perform related work. Work closely with engineers and management to resolve equipment problems of the highest technical difficulty and perform related work. Drive a motor vehicle.

REQUIREMENTS: Eight years of full-time Journey-Level experience (fully trained, knowledgeable, proficient and competent mechanic) in repair of electric/hydraulic elevators and/or escalators, or the equivalent.

ELEVATOR & ESCALATOR MAINTAINER:

Starting Rate: **\$38.29/hr***

JOB DUTIES: Maintain and repair electric and hydraulic elevators, escalators and associated electro-mechanical equipment. Clean and lubricate all components of elevators and escalators; keep records and perform related work. Drive a motor vehicle.

REQUIREMENTS: Three years of full-time Journey-Level experience (fully trained, knowledgeable, proficient and competent mechanic) in repair of electric/hydraulic elevators and/or escalators, or the equivalent.

LICENSE REQUIREMENT: Candidates for both positions will be required to possess a Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York at the time of appointment.

THESE POSITIONS OFFER: Paid vacation, holiday and sick leave; overtime and night differential; comprehensive health benefits; a pension plan; and a NYC Transit Bus and Subway employee pass.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Seating at the Open House is limited. Candidates will be screened prior to admission to the Open House. Entry to the Open House will be limited to candidates who:

1. Meet the minimum qualification requirements based on a preliminary review of their resume
2. Possess a Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York (bring your license to the Open House)
3. Have not previously interviewed for either position with New York City Transit within the past year
4. Have not failed a recent Civil Service Examination for Transit Electro-Mechanical Maintainer (Elevator and Escalator), Exam No. 7607

Candidates admitted to the Open House may be invited to participate in a one-hour written assessment and/or interview which may require them to spend up to three or four hours at the Open House.

You must bring **TWO COPIES** of your resume and your driver's license to the Open House.
