- B. The Work to be performed under this Contract may briefly be described as the Basic Overhaul and Additional Work for up to ~~forty-two~~ (40~~2~~) General Electric Model GT 558 Traction Generators, including all necessary or incidental work, labor and materials, in accordance with the annexed Technical Specifications (Section V). Included in the Work and price shall be all pickup, transportation and delivery expenses from and to the Authority as well as all labor, materials, equipment, incidentals and overhead costs and expenses in performing the Work. The Work shall be performed as specified in the Contract Documents at the production rate specified in **ARTICLE 104, TIME FOR COMPLETION AND DELIVERY**.
- C. The Contractor shall be required to perform all Work in accordance with the Technical Specifications and all drawings listed under Section IX, "Technical Specifications", annexed hereto and incorporated herein as part of the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 103 TERM OF CONTRACT
